If you are 16 or 17 and arrested for a felony, you could:

- Be tried as an adult in court
- Have your trial information and conviction on your record permanently
- If you are tried as an adult, be sent to adult prison

If you have a juvenile criminal record you might:

- NOT, be allowed in the Armed Forces
- NOT, be admitted to college
- NOT, get certain jobs
- NOT, get loans (educational, home, car)
- NOT, be able to rent a house or apartment
- NOT, get your driver's license
- NOT, be able to vote
- NOT, get a hunting license
- NOT, keep your criminal record private
